

Pool Fence



If you have a pool, you need a pool fence. The fence needs to pass the local safety code- at least 48" high, no slats larger than 4" wide, and no more than 4" from the bottom edge of the fence to the ground. All gates must be self-closing and latching. All doors from the home that are within the gated area must also have door alarms installed to pass the code inspections.

If you are having [Legendary Escapes](#) build your custom swimming pool, we can install your fence during the build project. We recommend [Fortress Iron Fence](#) or Single Rail in black for most fence installations around your swimming pool. Black is a nice, clean finishing color for a pool fence. Fences are just necessary and we would not spend a lot of time or money installing them. It will not take away from the beauty of your custom pool (unless you choose a bright white paint, that can be distracting). The fence can be installed so it slopes down/up around the pool if you are incorporating different elevations. The gates are built to code and would all have a self-closing hinge and self-latching mechanism per building codes.
